## New policy in the Guidelines for Parish Pastoral Councils

- 1. The Pastor is the Chair; there is no Vice-Chair.
- 2. There is a Secretary who takes minutes, keeps written documentation, and prepares a summary of each meeting for the whole parish.
- 3. The Executive Committee consists of three or four persons who assist the pastor in making the agenda for meetings.
- 4. Parochial Vicars are ex-officio.
- 5. Permanent Deacons not employed by the parish are ex-officio.
- 6. Lay employees of the parish should not be members.
- 7. There should be not fewer than six and no more than fifteen members, including the pastor.
- 8. The Council members should be presented at the Sunday liturgy.
- 9. Terms of service: three years, renewable one time.
- 10. The pastor may appoint ex-officio members of the staff, to be appointed annually.
- 11. The Council should not meet more than ten times a years.
- 12. The Secretary distributes the agenda and minutes to members.
- 13. The Council serves as consulter to the parish and may lead and coordinate the implementation of pastoral policy.
- 14. Pastor is to seek consensus, and not unanimity.
- 15. A synopsis of each meeting should be made known to the parish.
