
Lenten Food Drive – March 27 & 28

- Canned Meats/Fish; Tuna, Corned beef hash, Chili, Vienna sausage, etc.
- Soups, cup of noodles, single serve microwavable meals
- Rice, pasta, mac & cheese, instant potatoes,
- Cereal, oatmeal (boxes and individual serving packages)
