OUR NEEDS

We have long needed more community gathering space at St. Joseph's. As our 2022 parish-wide survey demonstrated clearly, we need to create additional room where more of our community can come join us—therefore, our top priority is a larger, more functional parish center with sufficient space to accommodate gatherings of our strong faith community and our ministries. We also need to refurbish our historic organ, which is in severe disrepair and held together by paper clips in places, and to renovate parts of the rectory and Madonna House basement. We are considering a capital campaign to raise funds for these projects.

OUR PROJECTS

NEW PARISH CENTER | \$3.5 million

We plan to build a two-story multipurpose parish center on the same site as the existing hall and connect it to the St. Thomas More Center, which also will receive substantial renovations. This new center will be a focal point for community events and ministry needs, and it will help build a more vibrant and engaged community, one that is better connected in a campus-like atmosphere. The new center, expected to open in 2026-2027, will feature:

- Nearly 3,900 square feet of usable space more than double the existing facilities.
- A large parish hall with space for 100 people seated for a meal and a full catering kitchen and pantry.
- An inviting entrance lobby and welcoming area.
- Four religious education classrooms and a recording and editing suite to enhance communications.
- Abundant and accessible restroom facilities, storage rooms and mechanical closets.
- A landscaped garden ideal for outdoor gathering and meditation.

ORGAN REFURBISHMENT | \$608,000

Our treasured Hook & Hastings mechanical action pipe organ, an integral part of the liturgy at St. Joseph's since the church was dedicated in 1891, will be completely refurbished and reinstalled. This critical work will ensure that our organ continues to fill our church with the beautiful sacred music that draws us into the liturgy and deepens our experience. Work is scheduled to begin in summer 2024 and will take approximately 13 months.

RECTORY AND MADONNA HOUSE UPGRADES | \$900,000

Key renovations to the rectory and the Madonna House basement will complement the new parish center and enhance our campus. During construction of the parish center – and after it opens – the rectory and Madonna House basement will provide event, meeting and gathering space. The proposed upgrades include:

- Remodeling the rectory's kitchen, restrooms, staff space and meeting space.
- Adding rectory restrooms accessible from outside during outdoor parish center events.
- Creating more space in the rectory for parish staff to function more effectively.
- Installing a door to safely separate the Madonna House basement from the personal living space.
- Adding an additional meeting room, kitchenette and restrooms to the Madonna House basement.
